

# IDSD 151: Crime & justice Behind

Brings together formerly incarcerated persons through weekly panel discussions that engage critical topics around contemporary criminal justice reform and engages students through dialogue around enduring questions that keep students engaged with the course content beyond each virtual session. Each session includes a panel to guide the discussion. In a debate style format, students break into small group rooms to triangulate information from required readings, directly impacted panel and personal insights.
